I get asked a lot of questions about **dog aggression**. It's pretty simple to explain canine aggression, but no-one ever wants to believe exactly how simple it really is. Dog aggression is actually not very hard to change, either.

Unfortunately the details are a little harder to explain. Unless someone has a really good working knowledge of differential reinforcement, generalisation, stimulus conditions etc it's something that is best left to an expert.

Unfortunately, finding a genuine expert is next to impossible, so if you have a dog with aggression problems, you virtually have to become your own expert.
